We would like to invite you, to send us your photos in support of the Patagonia WITHOUT Dams Campaign. With this initiative we would like to evidence the growing community of people who are working to defend Patagonia's Wild Rivers At Risk.

The construction of hydroelectric dams in Patagonia would not only have huge environmental, social and economic impact, but would also affect one of the biggest world freshwater reserves, the Northern and Southern Patagonian Ice Fields.

In view of Chile's enormous potential in the fields of Renewable Energies and Energy Efficiency, the construction of hydroelectric dams would be a retrograde response to the country's energy needs.

Chile's relatively short rivers and small river basins are very fragile ecosystems that are of great cultural value and enormous environmental quality. It is not necessary to intervene a World Wildlife Reserve like Patagonia if one can satisfy the energy needs by means of Renewable Energies and Energy Efficiency.
